Frédéric Bérard (LL.D., Université de Montréal) holds a Doctorate in Law and a Master's Degree in Political Science (M.A., McGill University), and completed postdoctoral studies in Philosophy at Université Laval. Specializing in constitutional and administrative law, he has been recognized by *Best Lawyers* as one of Canada's leading lawyers in his field.

A prolific and award-winning author, Bérard has written numerous essays on democracy and the rule of law. His work has earned recognition including nominations for the Donner Prize, the Prix des libraires and the Governor General's Literary Awards. His book *J'accuse les tortionnaires d'Omar Khadr* is also being adapted for film. His scholarly work has been cited with approval by the Quebec Court of Appeal and the Supreme Court of Canada, and he has delivered lectures and conferences across Canada and internationally.

A political and legal commentator on 98.5 FM, Noovo, Radio-Canada, CTV and CJAD, Bérard is also a spokesperson for Galahad, an organization dedicated to animal welfare and rights. A passionate educator, he has received 14 awards for excellence in university teaching. He is also President of Maelström Médias, a leading provider of continuing legal education.
